## **Official traineeship of the European Council of Young Farmers Requirements and conditions**

### **WHO?**

- You must have completed or are in the process of completing the first cycle of university studies in any discipline related to European Issues. Currently, the majority of applications come from candidates with qualifications in law, political science, international relations, agricultural technology, agronomics and economics. However, CEJA is also looking for trainees with qualifications in other fields, such as health and food safety, environment, energy management, financial management, evaluation and strategic analysis, design, multimedia, and so on.
- You must have a very good knowledge of English and/or French
- You have worked on individual projects before and have knowledge of common computer programmes
- You can work independently and in a team on the assigned topics and projects
- Languages from the New Member States would be welcome

### **WHEN?**

The CEJA traineeship programme is open for applications throughout the year and places are attributed on an individual basis according to the availabilities in the office. We currently have vacancies for February or March 2009.
